Online applications are invited in prescribed form available in the official website of the High Court of Tripura (<http://thc.nic.in>) from persons who are not below 18 years of age and not more than 40 years of age (45 years in case of candidate belonging to Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes) as on **12.10.2026** for filling up **01 (one)** vacant post of **Cook (Group-D)** in the establishment of the High Court of Tripura, Agartala:

Eligibility	1) Standard VIII passed 2) Experience in cooking 3) Must be free from any contagious diseases
Age Limit	Minimum 18 years and maximum 40 years for UR (as on 12.10.2026). The upper age limit is relaxable by 05 years for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (as on 12.10.2026).
Fees	Fee for UR category applicant is Rs.300/- (Rupees three hundred only). For reserved category (SC/ST) applicant it is Rs.150/- (Rupees one hundred fifty only).

IMPORTANT NOTES

- I. The number of posts to be filled up is likely to increase or decrease;
- II. A Panel of select list will be prepared on the basis of merit and it will remain valid for 01(one) year from the date of publication of the result;

- III. **ST/SC candidates of other States should apply as general candidate along with application fees prescribed for candidates of general category;**
- IV. Fees once deposited will not be refunded or adjusted for any other recruitment in future. Candidates are to deposit fees by using Credit Card (Visa/Master/Rupay), Net Banking, Debit Card (Visa/Master/Rupay), Wallets & Cash Cards & UPI only. No other mode of payment will be accepted. Bank charge may apply.

Disqualification for appointment– No person shall be eligible for appointment to the service:

- (a) Unless he is a citizen of India; or
- (b) If he has been dismissed from service by the Government, Central Government, High Court, statutory or Local Authority; or
- (c) If he has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude; or
- (d) If he has more than one spouse living; or
- (e) If he directly or indirectly tries to influence the recruiting authority by any means.

INSTRUCTIONS

I) ONLINE APPLICATION:

- a) Candidates have to submit application through Online Application Portal only. The High Court will not entertain any hard copy of application. Before submission of online application, the candidates are to read the instructions carefully in the 'How to Apply' segment of the Online Application Portal.
- b) Online Application Portal will be available on the High Court's Website (<https://thc.nic.in>) from **28.09.2026 (from 11:00 A.M) to 12.10.2025 (upto 05:00 P.M.)**. To apply the candidates have to click on the '**Recruitment**' tab in the Home page of the High Court's website.
- c) **The candidate shall be solely responsible for ensuring that his/her name and surname are correctly entered in the Online Application Form. Any error or discrepancy in the name or surname may render the candidate ineligible to appear in the Written Test/Selection Test.**
- d) Candidates should avoid submitting multiple applications. However, due to any unavoidable circumstances, if any candidate submits multiple applications then he/she must ensure that the application with latest Registration Number is complete in all respect.

- e) In case of multiple applications, the one with the latest Registration Number shall only be entertained by the High Court and Fee paid against one Registration Number shall not be adjusted against any other Registration Number.
- II) Candidates who are eligible for Written Test/Selection Test will be asked for scrutiny of original marks-sheets/certificates/documents before appearing in the Written Test/Selection Test.
- III) **The candidates already in Government Services shall upload 'No-Objection Certificate' from his/her employer.**
- IV) Candidates shall have to bear their own expenses for appearing in the Written Test/Selection Test.

SELECTION PROCESS OF COOK

The entire selection process shall be conducted in a single phase, namely:

Skill Test on Cooking (Practical Examination): Marks: 100

Assessment Criteria shall include:

- (1) Preparation of Dishes (as prescribed by the Selection Committee)
- (2) Taste, quality and presentation of food
- (3) Hygiene and cleanliness during preparation and handling of food
- (4) Time management and efficiency
- (5) Basic knowledge of nutrition and balanced diet
- (6) Basic knowledge of different kinds of spices and cooking ingredients

Candidates must secure a minimum of 60% marks, relaxable by 10% in the case of reserved category candidates, to be considered for selection.
